MAIN GALLERY EXHIBIT PROPOSAL

Thank you for your interest in having a Main Gallery Exhibit at the Carbon County Arts Guild & Depot Gallery. Our Search & Review Committee, which meets monthly throughout most of the year, chooses the artists that will exhibit in our Main Gallery and also the dates for those exhibits. In order to be considered for a Main Gallery Exhibit, we require a written proposal. Once the S&R Committee meets to consider your written proposal, the Executive Director will notify you of the results.

Written Proposal Must Include:

- At least five (5) photographs that are representative of the artwork that is proposed for a Main Gallery Exhibit. Photos may be submitted on CD, actual photographs, or artist brochure. Artists may request that the S&R Committee view photos on a website as long as the website is provided and the remaining parts of the proposal are submitted in writing.
- Artist's Statement
- Resume including past exhibit list
- Biography in narrative format
- Contact information, including name, address, telephone number, and email address
- Self addressed envelope/padded mailer with sufficient postage for return of proposal. Proposals received without return envelope and sufficient postage will be destroyed.

For those groups of artists that wish to have a large group exhibit, contact the Executive Director prior to completing the application process for additional guidance.

All artwork in a Main Gallery Exhibit must be for sale. The Arts Guild receives 40% commission from all sales. Since the Arts Guild works closely with area schools, work of a violent or sexual nature cannot be accepted.
